


**What next?** Like the rest of society, here in school we are looking forward to the easing of certain measures from 17th May and then again, all being well, from 21st June.



**From the 17th May...**we can make some subtle, but very welcome changes in school. The children will be able to sit in groups rather rows within their classes, we can all have lunch together in the hall (but we will still remain in our class

groups as opposed to mixing classes). Start and finish times no longer need to be staggered but parents dropping off their children must continue to wear face masks and socially distance.

Children should arrive no earlier than 8.50am. Children in Reception and Year

1 must enter school through their side door and go straight to their classroom. Children in Year 2 - 6 must enter via the front door and go straight to their classrooms where they will be met by their teachers. At the end of the school day (3.30pm), parents must wait for their children at the front of school as Reception and Year 1 children will leave via their side door and children in Year 2 - 6 will leave via the front door.

**From the 21st June...**we are really hoping that we can return to normal and as such, we have planned several events to celebrate our new found freedom! It will be a busy final 5 weeks of the school year as we try and cram a years worth of activities in but I am sure the children will benefit from what we have got planned. Additional letters outlining more details will be sent nearer the time.

**Vision and Hearing screening** From September the NHS will no longer be visiting schools to conduct the Vision and Hearing checks. This will become the responsibility of parents to arrange themselves with providers such as Boots, Specsavers etc. The checks will continue to be free for children.
